<u>Benefits</u>

- Walks are not <u>a</u> cornerstone of Volkssporting they are <u>the</u> cornerstone of Volkssporting! You will discover the heart of Volkssporting and how Volkssporting functions.
- This is an excellent volunteer opportunity for a new member or a member who wishes to learn more about how Volkssporting operates.
- As Box Tender, you are the boss of your walk. You may make changes to your walk to keep it interesting and fun!

Time Requirement

• Approximately one hour monthly per walk box, depending on the box's location.

Position Elements

- Monitor Walk Box
 Ensure blank registration forms are available for walkers
 Ensure that a supply of current walk directions is available for walkers
 Ensure walk instructions are updated with current challenges
 Stock the walk box with current club and event promotional material
- Monthly Report
 - Collect registration sheets for the month

Prepare and submit a monthly report (the form for this is provided) along with collected money to Treasurer

• Sanctioning

Yearly (August) - submit updated information, including which new challenges your walk satisfies, to the Vice President so that your walk may be sanctioned by the AVA.

Yearly CVC dues are:
