How does "Capitol City Wanderers" sound for a new name? It retains the word "Capitol" so we don't completely lose the name recognition that we've had over the past 35 plus years, and it's a tribute to our club's location and history. It eliminates the word "club" which sometimes deters people because of its connotation of various requirements for commitment. It uses a noun indicating casual, interesting, outdoor activity - "wanderers".

Why do we need to think about changing our name?

Mass Media Corporate Communications is the public relations firm that AVA has hired to develop a marketing campaign for AVA. The first recommendation they made was to eliminate the word "volkssport" and "volksmarch" from our club names. We spend a lot of time explaining these words when we should be simply saying "come walk with us". We need to order more business cards, and before we order more logo wear, we need to know what our name is going to be.

Isn't it going to be too much work to get our IRS records, nonprofit status, and bank accounts changed to the new name?

At the recent ESVA meeting I walked with Regional Director Tom Baltes. His home club, Vancouver USA Volkssporters, has already changed their name to Vancouver Walking Club. I asked him about all the paperwork involved in doing this. He said there is none. We can simply start using our new name on our website, in *The Pathfinder*, Newsletter, *TAW*, Meetup, business cards and any other print or electronic publications or logo wear. Although our IRS and bank name remains the same, we will be doing business as (d/b/a) our new name.

The public won't be able to find our website because it will have a different name than our club name.

Webmaster, Peter Sweet, says he will have to check to make sure that the domain name we want is available and there will be a charge for buying the new domain name. Changing our website name is doable

Do club members get a chance to give input into this decision? Absolutely! We'll be discussing name change at our May and June meetings and will vote on it at our July meeting. Although, I have to be honest with you and let you know that I will vote against "The Olympia Streetwalkers" and "The Lost Looky Loonies" which are names that have been suggested to me! May we use our abilities, skills, creativity, and open minds to carry us through this evolution successfully.
