

CVC Annual Box Tender Meeting



The meeting was called to order and the following topics were discussed:

1. Pam Greig-Davis presented the 2026 form from ESVA for the new Challenges, and those still active, which should be included in every start box for the coming year. The form is not yet available on the website, but it will be soon, and Pam can also send it to box tenders via email.
2. It was decided that all walks currently sanctioned for the club be continued for 2026, exactly as they are designated at present.
3. The group discussed the walks released by the former Tulip Trekkers club, and agreed to take over three particular walks for the Capitol Volkssport Club, including Bellingham Marina, Bellingham Fairhaven-Waterfront-WWU, and the Peace Arch Walk. Chase Davis stated he would take them on as Box Tender, though they are all Online Startbox only. The group agreed to explore the possibility of scheduling a Bellingham-based traditional event, including a joint Canadian/American event at Peace Arch for next year.
4. Pam Greig-Davis presented the financial results of the last two Wild and Woodsy events, which earned around \$1200-\$1600 to argue for planning for a 2026 event. As we would have the availability of the Police and Sheriff's organization building again for 2026, which we can use free of charge, it was decided to go ahead with plans for the event, subject to a vote of the full club membership. Several updated walks and plans for an updated pub crawl were then discussed, which can be fleshed out closer to the event, should the club approve.
5. Sheila Morrison announced that CVC membership forms were redone with current club contacts, and that all box tenders should check their boxes for corrected forms, as several have been shown to be out of date. The forms can be downloaded from our website.
6. The meeting was adjourned, and we all went downstairs to look at Jim's trains!
